



Data protection information pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 GDPR as part of application for the Dr. Wolfgang Hevert Prize 2024

Article 13 GDPR describes the information to be provided if data is collected from the data subject, and Article 14 describes which is to be provided if it has not been obtained from the data subject. We are hereby informing you the processing of your personal data.

Purposes of data processing and information on it

In cooperation with the Hevert-Foundation, Hevert-Arzneimittel grants the Dr. Wolfgang Hevert Prize every other year, which acknowledges scientific study in the field of holistic medicine with an advancement award. Applicants can work either as university staff or independently, and the choice of topics is free. A research paper or project description must be submitted by the deadline in order to apply. A jury of experts selects the recipient of the advancement award. The prize is awarded by the Hevert-Foundation.

The following personal data is processed as part of your application:

- First name, last name
- Academic title, profession, specialist field/department
- Form of professional activity: employed or self-employed
- University mailing address or personal mailing address (postal code, city/town, street and number)
- E-mail address, phone number(s)
- Data from your curriculum vitae in tabular format (with optional photo)
- Submitted research paper / project description, including budgeting
- Details of scientific publications and prizes/stipends received in the past two years as well as the details of any financial consideration for your scientific activity and any existing business relationships with people/companies connected to your research

The **legal basis** for processing **your personal data** is Article 6 (1b) GDPR (steps prior to entering into a contract, performance of a contract) since by applying for the advancement award, you are entering into a contractual relationship with Hevert-Foundation and with Hevert-Arzneimittel.

Your personal data and/or photos/videos of you as part of promotional measures connected to the awarding of the prize will be published only if you have given us your consent for this in writing pursuant to Article 6 (1a) GDPR.

Recipients of your personal data

Within Hevert-Foundation and Hevert-Arzneimittel, the only people who receive your personal data are those who require it to fulfill one of the above purposes and to accomplish their tasks. In addition, the members of the jury receive your information in order to select the winner of the advancement award. The members of the jury are sworn to secrecy by us.

We use a service provider (agency) to organize, execute, market, and communicate all matters relating to the advancement award, with whom we have concluded a contract for processing pursuant to Article 28 GDPR.





No unlawful disclosure of your personal data or unlawful transfer to a non-European country occurs.

Storage period

We delete your personal data once it is no longer required for the specified purposes and as long as this is not opposed by statutory or contractual documentation/retention obligations. Apart from that, pursuant to data protection regulations, deletion occurs six weeks after the Dr. Wolfgang Hevert Prize is announced and awarded in order to be able to respond to potential objections related to the granting of the advancement award.

Your rights

You have the following rights in regard to your personal data:

- The right of access pursuant to Article 15 GDPR;
- To rectification pursuant to Article 16 GDPR;
- To erasure / to be forgotten pursuant to Article 17 GDPR;
- To restriction of processing pursuant to Article 18 GDPR;
- To data portability pursuant to Article 20 GDPR;
- To object pursuant to Article 21 GDPR.

Please note: Revoking the use of your personal data before conclusion of the selection, awarding, and publication process for the Dr. Wolfgang Hevert Prize 2024 implies the revocation of your application.

Furthermore, you have the right to lodge complaints with a supervisory authority if you have legitimate evidence of a data protection violation. To do so, you can contact the supervisory authority in your usual place of residence or the competent authority for the Hevert-Foundation or Hevert-Arzneimittel. These are:
